Located at the Dane County Courthouse (214 South Hamilton Street, Madison), and operating from 11:30 to 1:30 every Wednesday. Services are free and not restricted by economic need or residence.

**Green County
Family Law Clinic**

- The Clinic is available the first and third Fridays of each month at Green County Human Services in the Green County Government Services Building, N3152 Hwy 81, Monroe, WI. Use main entrance.
- You must schedule your appointment in person at Green County Human Services and complete a short intake form (no walk-ins) and prove economic need.
- Appointments are in 45-minute blocks starting at 8:30 am.
- Be early, and bring all legal paperwork with you
- The Clinic assists with family law issues only.
- The Clinic helps complete paperwork only and gives NO legal advice or legal representation.

The **Green County Family Law Clinic** is a no cost service for people who are representing themselves in Court. The service is solely to assist you in properly completing as many of the correct forms as possible so that the Court will understand what you are asking.

The Clinic hours are the first and third Fridays of each month. To use the Clinic, you must schedule an appointment in person at the reception desk on 1st floor in the Economic Assistance unit at the Green County Government Services Building.

There is no charge for the service, but you must prove economic need.

We do **NOT** provide legal representation.

We do **NOT** provide legal advice.

You are required to sign a release indicating you understand that the Green County Family Law Clinic or volunteer helping you does not represent you.

The Clinic is staffed entirely by Green County attorneys and experienced volunteers who know family law issues. The Clinic does not keep any records or copies of documents.

If the attorney has a conflict of interest in your case, they cannot assist you. This means that you would have to schedule for a different day when a different attorney is staffing the Clinic.
